Any person who considers that he has an interest, right or easement in or over such foreshore and sea-bed that will be injuriously affected by the undertaking may deliver a written claim for compensation for the injurious affection to the Director of Lands, 20th Floor, North Point Government Offices, 333 Java Road, North Point, Hong Kong before the expiration of 1 year from the date of publication of this notice in the *Gazette*, stating the sum of money which he is willing to accept in full and final settlement of his claim together with such particulars as he may possess to substantiate the claim.

SCHEDULE

Foreshore and sea-bed affected

Approximately 200 hectares of foreshore and sea-bed to the northeast of Tung Chung as delineated and shown edged red on a plan, numbered ISM2583b, deposited in the Land Registry.

Description of the undertaking and the manner in which the foreshore and sea-bed will be affected by the proposed undertaking

- 1. Construction of approximately 4.9 kilometres of seawall;
- Filling of the sea-bed to form approximately 129 hectares of land for Tung Chung New Town extension and construction of Road P1 (Tung Chung—Tai Ho Section), joining to North Lantau Highway near Tai Ho; and
- Demolition of the existing Pak Mong Pier and re-provisioning of landing steps in new seawall nearby.
